




FOR BETTER FUNCTION

Sufficient ventilation is required



Proper ventilation is recommended for more effective ECOCARAT performance and to help control humidity.

Ventilate frequently for 1 to 2 weeks after installation



The moisture of the the adhesive may be present in the room and room temperature may increase.

Avoid contact with fabric



The uneven surface of Ecocarat Plus tiles may damage fabric.

Avoid sharp objects



The tile surface may be scratched or scraped.

Do not use hooks, screws or hammers



Doing so can cause cracks and breakage. Please consult contractor.





DAILY CARE

Dust regularly with a clean cloth. Avoid washing with water directly.



- Use of mild household detergent will enhance cleaning results
- Remove stains using melamine foam cleaning sponge
- For best results, use melamine foam sponge and mild detergent



Cleaning Recommendation

For best results we suggest the use of a melamine foam sponge for the treatment of dirt and stains shown.

Detergents containing bleach: Read precautions before use.

General household cleaners refer to mild, non-abrasive agents used to clean furniture, wall paper, windows, electronics, etc, and can be used to clean tiles. Do not use thinners or cleansers with acids. Doing so will damage the surface and characteristics of the tile.



Hard to remove stains must be treated promptly for best results.

Other:

- Paint tool
- -Pen (water based, oil based)
- -Crayon
- -Nail polish

Removal of Tough Stains

- Please be careful for dirt and detergent to turn to neither the side nor the back at the time of cleaning. Please use a line stick etc. if needed.
- Remove dirt and spills promptly as set-in stains may be difficult to remove by the methods noted above.
- To remove tough stains, use mild detergent on a toothbrush and gently work into the stain. Stain may be permanent if allowed to absorb over time.
- Regular care and inspection is recommended to maintain the beauty of the tile.
